
Summary of Regulations:

(see Loves Park Zoning Ordinance, Article VI. Signs for further regulations)

Temporary Signage (banners, placards, poster panels, etc.) Location Requirements:

- 1. On an existing sign structure so that such sign or attention-getting device meets all sign height and location requirements for the zoning district in which it is located.
- 2. On a building so that such sign or attention-getting device does not project out from the building or above the roofline.
- 3. Is not permitted in residential zoning districts.
- 4. May not face a parcel zoned residential with common lot lines.
- 5. May not be within 10 feet of a property line UNLESS there is a minimum 6 foot clearance from the ground to the base of the sign or attention-getting device.
- 6. May not be located within the vision triangle.

Illustration depicts temporary signage placement for signs within 10 feet of a property line with street frontage.



Inflatable (balloons, etc.) Location Requirements:

- 1. On an existing sign structure so that such inflatable meets all sign height and location requirements for the zoning district in which it is located.
- 2. On the roof of a building or canopy in which the business is located.
- 3. On the property in which the business is located, within the building setbacks, provided such inflatable does not reduce the required parking, ingress/egress, travel lanes, or impede the Americans with Disability Act compliance.
- 4. May not face a parcel zoned residential with common lot lines.

Walking Advertiser (mascots, etc.) Requirements:

- 1. Walking advertisers must remain on the zoning lot in which the business is located or in a location up to 5 feet away from the roadway adjacent to the zoning lot in which the business is located.
- 2. Walking advertisers may not reduce the required parking, ingress/egress, travel lanes, impede the Americans with Disability Act compliance, or be located in the vision triangle on a corner property for a distance of 30 feet from the intersecting property lines.
- 3. Walking advertisers may be in costume and/or have signage that is a permanent part of a person or mascot's costume. Walking advertisers MAY NOT hold or carry temporary signs or attention-getting devices.
