- 5. NEW BUSINESS:

Police Department – Initial Officer Hiring Process: The Commission reviewed the Notice for the testing process. Attorney Pirages Reynolds informed the Commission that the Notice will be published, in accordance with state statute, by the Rock River Times and posted in City Hall. The Commissioners also reviewed testing information from Stanard. The Commissioners then reviewed an invoice from The Blue Line which was previously approved at the February 20, 2018 meeting. The Commissioners discussed the testing dates and times, and Commissioners Scott and Lindberg agreed to attend the written and/or POWER tests on April 14, 2018. The Commissioners also discussed the application review process and agreed on the following review criteria to be formally summarized by Attorney Pirages Reynolds: application completeness; criminal history; job history; employment experience; location; age; qualifications; and other factors deemed by the Commissioners to be important as reflecting adversely upon the relative capacity of the applicant to discharge the duties of a police officer in the City of Loves Park.

> Water Department - Hiring Inquiry: Commissioner Daughtry noted a vacancy in a maintenance position in the Water Department.
