



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 102 - ZONING, ARTICLE III, DISTRICTS, SECTION 102-132 (E), OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LOVES PARK

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend certain portions of Chapter 102 - Zoning, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Zoning Board of Appeals was held thereon after due notice in the manner provided by law, and

WHEREAS, said Board has made a report recommending the approval of the Text Amendment, and

WHEREAS, the City of Loves Park is authorized and empowered by the Statute to adopt and enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVES PARK, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Amend Article III, Districts, Division 1, Generally, Section 102-132 (e) as follows:

Fencing regulations. All fences shall be installed with the finished site facing the adjacent property and fence posts facing the property on which the fence is placed. There shall be no height restrictions for open mesh type fencing used to enclose publicly owned parks, recreation areas, or school sites. In all cases, barbed wire is not permitted. Fences shall not be permitted in recorded drainage easements.

All other provisions of Chapter 102, Article III, Districts, shall remain in effect as previously published.
