BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVES PARK, ILLINOIS:

WHEREAS, upon the petition for a Special Use Permit as provided for in Ordinance No. 795 of the City of Loves Park, Illinois and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Zoning Board of Appeals was held thereon after due notice in the manner provided by law, and

WHEREAS, said Board has made a report containing findings of fact and recommending the approval of the Special Use Permit

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVES PARK, ILLINOIS:

That a Special Use Permit for a fitness establishment in the CR (Commercial Retail) Zoning District under the terms of the Zoning Ordinance No. 795 of the City of Loves Park, Illinois, is hereby granted on property legally described as follows:

Parcel 1

Windsor Lake Parkway (Private Drive) as designated upon the Plat of Windsor Lake Subdivision, being a Subdivision of part of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of Section 32, Township 45 North, Range 2 East of the Third Principal Meridian, the Plat of which is recorded in Book 37 of Plats on Page 91B in the Recorder's Office of Winnebago County, Illinois.

Parcel 2

Part of Lot Eight (8), as designated upon the Plat of Windsor Lake Subdivision, being a subdivision of part of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of Section 32. Township 45 North, Range 2 East of the Third Principal Meridian, the plat of which subdivision is recorded in Book 37 of Plats on Page 91B in the Recorder's Office of Winnebago County, Illinois, Bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Lot; thence North 892-23'-43" East, along the North line of said Lot, a distance of 261.27 feet to the Northeast corner of said Lot; thence South 0012-04'-08" East, along the East line of said Lot, a distance of 400.0 feet to an angle point in said line; thence South 892-23'-43" West, along a South line of said Lot, and said line extended West, a distance of 261.29 feet to an angle point in the West line of said Lot; thence North 002-03'758" West, along the West line of said Lot, a distance of 400.0 feet to the point of beginning. 

- 1. The Special Use Permit shall expire with the discontinuance of the fitness establishment, or change in business ownership.
- 2. The Special Use Permit shall be revoked with verified complaints from adjacent businesses, residents, or local authorities.
- 3. All items used for training shall be confined to the unit. Low impact, low noise exercise shall be permitted outside of the building.

The findings and recommendation of the Zoning Board of Appeals on the question of granting this Special Use Permit, in addition to the Site Plan approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals, are hereby accepted, adopted and made a part of this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
